



Amador County Fair Independent Junior Exhibitor Rules and Information

Enclosed are the official rules and forms for Junior (Jr.) Independent Exhibitors. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure all rules and deadlines are met. To be eligible for the Jr. Livestock show and sale, all records must be maintained on the project animal(s) and submitted to the Fair at arrival.

Rules

Exhibitor Eligibility

1. To be eligible for the Amador County Fair Jr. Livestock Show and Sale, the independent exhibitor must be a qualified independent junior exhibitor from Amador County (Refer to State and Livestock Rules in Amador County Fair Premium Book for eligibility and qualifications).
2. Exhibitor must have current Quality Assurance and Ethics training. The website for this training is www.yqca.org. Proof of training must be submitted:
 - a. Market Animal(s) Exhibitors: **Designated pre-weigh date(s)**
 - b. Horse Exhibitors: **March 26, 2022**
 - c. Breeding Animal(s) Exhibitors: **June 17, 2022**
3. Exhibitor must adhere to the dress code outlined in the Amador County Fair Rules.
4. Exhibitor and chaperone(s) shall adhere to all other Amador County Fair Rules to maintain eligibility for any shows.



Project Eligibility

1. Market Animal Projects must be declared (Declaration of Intent) and weighed at the designated pre-weigh date.
2. Horse Projects must be declared (Declaration of Intent) by **March 26, 2022** (see State and Livestock Rules for ownership/lease requirements)
3. Breeding Projects must be declared (Declaration of Intent) by June 17, 2022 (see State and Livestock Rules for breeding animal ownership requirements)
4. A Project Management Record Book shall be maintained and submitted upon arrival to the fair to the appropriate office.
 - a. Livestock (Market & Breeding): Jr. Livestock Office
 - b. Horses: Horse Show Office

Should an exhibitor fail to maintain record book and submit to the fair, the exhibitor and projects entered will be disqualified and be unable to show and/or sell at the Amador County Fair.

NO EXCEPTIONS

5. Declaration of Intent: When submitting the Declaration on Intent, the following is required:
 - a. Declaration of Intent Form
 - i. Must be complete, with signatures.
 - b. Must have two photos (exhibitor is encouraged to be present in photos)
 - i. Side view of animal
 - ii. Front view of animal
 - c. Declaration of Intent forms and photos must be submitted by:
 - i. Market Animals: close of pre-weigh on designated date
 - ii. Horse and Breeding: close of business on designated date

Should an exhibitor fail to submit the declaration of intent to the fair by the designated date and time, the exhibitor and project(s) will be unable to enter the Livestock Market, Breeding Show or Horse Show. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

6. Exhibitor must provide insurance for project(s) and submit to fair by date entries close. See fair website for date. www.amadorcountyfair.com
