

## Uploading a Video to YouTube for the 2020 Virtual Sale


**Step 1:** On <a href="www.youtube.com">www.youtube.com</a>, select the video camera icon in the upper right-hand corner, then select upload video.




**Step 2:** If not already signed in, you will be asked to sign in. If you do not have a google account, you will need to set one up. Google accounts are free. If you are already signed in, please go to step 3




Step 3: Click "Select Files" and then select the video file saved on your device.






**Step 4:** Name Video Using the format "First Name Last Name, Club or Chapter, Eartag Number". For Sheep & Goats, use the Scrapies number. There will be a link provided on the side column, please save this link and submit once video has finished uploading




**Step 5:** Select "No, it's not made for kids", then select "Next"




Step 6: Select "Next" again



**Step 7:** Select "Unlisted" or "Public". <u>DO NOT</u> use "Private" as we will not be able to share that with the auction platform. An unlisted video is able to be viewed by anyone with the link, however it is not listed on the YouTube site or searchable by the general public. A public video is listed on the YouTube site and searchable by the general public. After selecting your visibility setting, click "Save".



**Step 8:** If you see the screen window titled "Video Published", your upload is complete. Please submit this link to the declaration of sale form. If you see the "video uploading screen" wait until it is 100% uploaded and the "Video processing screen" appears. After the video processing is complete, you can close the screen. If you need to find your video link again, please see below.



**Step 9:** If you need to access your video link again, hover over the video and click on the three dots, then select "Get shareable link". This will automatically copy the link and you can paste it into a word document or into the survey.
