(Cost of evaluation and sale will need to be cost-neutral to the fair and any overhead costs not covered by sponsorships will be divided between all sale lots.)

MINIMUM BIDS FOR SALE

PAYMENT

All livestock sales are considered cash sales and cash, check or Visa/MasterCard are accepted. The credit card used to register on EZ2Bid.com will NOT be charged. Buyers will be invoiced after the close of the sale from the Amador County Fair.

- Balances are due, in full, on the day of the auction, unless prior written arrangements have been made with the Fair Office. Accounts that remain unpaid at the close of business on the 30th day following the auction will be assessed a delinquent finance charge. Charges will be assessed at the rate of 20% per month from the date of sale (Saturday, July 25, 2020) until paid in full. Such delinquent accounts will be referred to collection and collection costs will be added to the Buyer's invoice. Delinquent buyers may, at the discretion of Fair Management, be excluded from participation in future auctions.
- Buyers may designate agents to purchase animals on buyer's behalf by submitting written authorization designating the agent to Fair Management prior to the sale.
- Multiple buyers who join to purchase a single lot are jointly liable for the full purchase price.
- All credit card transactions will be assessed a 3% convenience fee to cover bank fees incurred due to the Jr. Livestock sale.
- Buyers will be able to give exhibitor "add-ons" until Monday, July 27, 2020 at 3:00 pm.
