MARKET ANIMAL DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

SUNDAY, JULY 26TH, 2020

(LAST UPDATED: JULY 8, 2020)

I. <u>Drop-Off Procedures</u>

- a. For each species drop off time, please see the schedule.
- b. Vehicles will enter through the livestock gate near Wolin Arena (Empire Street).
- c. Vehicles will pull through the camping area and behind the beef barn (near beef wash racks) for unloading. **See map on next page**
- d. Only exhibitors will be allowed to exit the vehicle for unloading the animal. If an exhibitor is unable to complete this by themselves, one parent may exit and assist. Drivers must remain in the vehicle.
- e. The exhibitor will walk the animal down the aisle toward the sheep, goat, and swine barns.
- f. Animals will be marked for custom or resale and then be loaded onto the livestock transport truck.
- g. Once animals have been loaded, the exhibitor must return to their vehicle and leave the grounds.

II. Paperwork Requirements

- a. All market animals must have <u>another</u> completed medication form prior to arriving on the fairgrounds. Please have form filled out, signed, and ready to submit.
- b. Market Beef must have a yellow transportation slip.

III. Safety Measures

- a. Per Governor Newsom's updated mandate on facial coverings for state facilities, all personnel, volunteers and guests will be required to wear a mask, or other face covering, that covers their nose and mouth while on grounds and interacting with others.
- b. Hand sanitizer and/or disinfectant will be on site and readily available. Equipment and gates will be sanitized as needed.
- c. All personnel, volunteers, and guests will maintain physical distancing and proper hygiene.
- d. Before entering the fairgrounds, every person will go through the approved COVID-19 screening process and turn in the required waivers and/or questionnaires.

IV. Important Reminders!

a. If an exhibitor has more than one species that they are dropping off (ex. A steer and a lamb/goat), they may bring both animals during the earlier drop-off time.
